

Simon Oxarart, aged 56, and an old resident of the city, died suddenly at 2:30 o'clock yesterday afternoon at the home of Mrs. Smith on Virginia avenue. He had just been over to the San Fernando-street depot and had a fainting spell. Being brought back to his lodgings at Mrs. Smith's, he seemed to have another attack, and Dr. Carlisle was sent for. When he arrived, however, the patient was dead. Coroner Weldon was notified and came at once to view the body, upon which an inquest will be held this morning at Orr & Sutch's on Spring street. It is supposed that death was from heart disease, as the deceased was subject to that complaint.

Mr. Oxarart was an uncle of Simon Gless, who lives on Boyle avenue, and also of Mrs. Celestine, wife of the stableman of that name. The landed interests of the deceased were very large, and the value of the estate will probably reach well up toward \$500,000.
