Pierre Larronde Run Over by Two Women Drivers

Last evening at about 6 o'clock Pierre Larronde, a well-known resident and pioneer of Los Angeles, was seriously injured by being run over by a buggy. He was crossing Main street at the junction when two women came along, driving fast, and before Mr. Larronde could get out of the way the front wheel of the buggy struck him, knocking him down and severely cutting his face, besides rendering him insensible.

He was picked up and carried into Heinzemann's drug store, where some friends recognized him and procuring a carriage sent him home. The women who ran over him did not stop to see the extent of the damage done, but drove away at a rapid gate.

Inquiry at Mr. Larronde's residence elicited the fact that the injuries, as far as could be found out, were not serious. He had received a cut over the right eye and several severe bruises. Mr. Larronde is 70 years of age, and an accident of this kind, with the attendant shock, may prove somewhat serious. He refused to call in a physician, and at last accounts was resting comparatively easy.
