

E. SENTOUS DROPS DEAD.

**Former Partner of Brother in Local
Meat Business Stricken on Street
by Apoplexy.**

Exupere Sentous, brother of Vincent and Louis Sentous, and for years engaged in the meat industry here, dropped dead at Temple and Franklin streets at 10:30 o'clock yesterday morning. Apoplexy was the cause of death. The body was taken to the Receiving Hospital and later was removed to the undertaking establishment of Pierce Bros.

Apparently enjoying the best of health, Mr. Sentous left his ranch at Lemon yesterday morning and came to Los Angeles on business. He was alone at the time he was stricken.

In 1880 Mr. Sentous came to California and engaged in the meat business, retiring a few years ago in the enjoyment of a comfortable fortune. A widow and four children mourn his loss. His two brothers are the only other immediate relatives, but there are a host of nephews, nieces and grandchildren. Exupere Sentous was born in France and was 47 years old.
