

PROMINENT PASADENA ELK IS SUMMONED BY DEATH

PASADENA, April 19.—Henry Luc, widely known in Pasadena and formerly of the firm of Luc & Seeley, now dissolved, died this evening at his home, near the foothills. Mr. Luc's death was due to tuberculosis, a disease from which he had suffered several years.

Mr. Luc was once quite prominent in the local lodge of Elks, and his funeral will be attended by that body at St. Andrew's church on Sunday at 2 o'clock. Failing health led him, nearly two years ago, to give up business, and since that time he has lived in Altadena in the vain hope of recovering his health.
