
PIONEER GONE HENCE.

Juan Ordoqui, Thirty-seven Years In Southern California, Dies at His Home in This City.

Juan Ordoqui, a pioneer of Southern California, died late last night at his home, No. 1410 Temple street. He was aged 62 years, and had spent thirty-seven years in Southern California, most of the time on a ranch in Orange county. For twenty years he had led a retired life in this city. He leaves a widow and two children, Mrs. Dolores Eseberry and Manuel Ordoqui, proprietor of the Café Martin.

Ordoqui was a native of France, having been born in the Pyrennees Mountains.
