

FUNERAL TO BE TODAY.

Wealthy Cattleman Who Recently Completed Building at First and Alameda Streets is Dead.

The funeral of Domingo Oyharzabal, a wealthy cattleman and land owner of San Juan Capistrano, who died last Friday at the home of J. B. Tipbalado, No. 2616 Dalton avenue, will be held this morning from No. 810 South Fowler street. A special requiem mass will follow at St. Vincent's Church. The interment will be in Calvary Cemetery.

Oyharzabal came to California in the late fifties from one of the Basque provinces in France. He settled first in Santa Clara county, later went to Kern county and in the early seventies settled at San Juan Capistrano, where he has amassed a fortune dealing in cattle, in walnut groves and in town realty. He recently completed a business building at Alameda and First street, valued at \$100,000. His only heir is a brother, Esteban, who has been his business partner.
