

Two Wright Act Violators Taken Saturday Evening

Jesus Cordero and Alejandro Echito were arrested Saturday evening by Constable W. J. Tebo, Marshal H. E. Mogle and Manuel Joseph, of the District Attorney's office, and charged with violation of the Wright act. Cordero was booked for the sale of three pints of intoxicating liquor and Echito with possession of the same.

Echito pleaded guilty to the possession charge and was assessed a fine of \$400 which he paid. Cordero decided not to enter a plea Monday morning when arraigned before Judge Durrell and trial was set for August 5.

Later in the day he changed his mind and entered a plea of guilty whereupon he was fined \$250 and given 90 days in jail. The jail sentence was suspended upon the condition that Cordero shake the dust of Chino from his feet and never return. It is understood that he complied with the decision.
