

HASQUET SUES G. N. FOR \$30,000 DAMAGES

An action for damages in amount of \$30,000 has been filed in district court by Jean Hasquet against the Great Northern Railway company.

The suit is brought in connection with the death of Mr. and Mrs. Mike Hasquet in August, 1925, caused by the Hasquets being struck by No. 27 at the railway crossing. In this accident four others also met death. R. L. Clinton is attorney for Mr. Hasquet.

Another action, filed October 11, is that of Barney Hurley vs. Hogberg and others, wherein Hurley sues for \$5,000 damages and the cancellation of an oil and gas lease. Donovan & Kelley are attorneys for the plaintiff.
