## Seven Californians Heirs to Estate

POMONA, Calif., Aug. 27.—(P)—Seven residents of southern California have fallen heir to a castle and great estate in the French province of Oloron in the Pyrennes mountains near the Spanish border. Two of the heirs, Stephen Mirande of Pomona, and Mrs. Marcelline Barry of Pasadena, have planned to sail from New York on Sept. 3 to represent their claims formally in France, it was announced today. The other heirs are Mrs. Carrie Vejar, Anaheim; John Mirande of Bakersfield, Mrs. Anna Esplad Grace and Robert Mirande of Pomona.

Grat Mirande, father of the seven to whom he has left the Oloron estate, together with Paris income property and \$300,000 in cash, came to America in 1867 and made a fortune in vineyards and wine making in the San Gabriel valley. He returned to France in 1911 and seeking out the province of his birth, purchased from relatives his ancestral castle and estates. He died mayor of his village a year ago.

None of the California heirs want the French castle, according to Miss Grace Mirande, who announced today the inheritance of the property by herself and her brothers and sisters. The heirs probably will decide to sell the castle, she said.
