

## HUNDREDS PAY TRIBUTE TO PIONEER

*Funeral Conducted for  
Mrs. Bernadette Sentous,  
Noted for Charity*

St. Vincent's Church was crowded to capacity when hundreds gathered yesterday to pay tribute to the memory of Mrs. Bernadette Sentous, who died Sunday at the family residence, on South Hobart Boulevard. Officiating at the services was Father O'Malley of St. Vincent's Church, with Father Grogan of Ventura and Father Martinez in the sanctuary. Interment was at Calvary Cemetery.

Palbearers were Alvin, Johnny Emile and Frank Sentous, nephews of Mrs. Sentous, and Domingo Amestoy and Edward Gibbs.

Father O'Malley called special attention to the many charitable deeds of Mrs. Sentous, who was a member of St. Agnes Church, but who had asked that her funeral services be conducted at St. Vincent's Church, since it was at that church that final tributes had been paid to her husband, Louis Sentous, and their son, Jules.

Mrs. Sentous, who was 77 years of age, became a resident of Los Angeles long before the days of street cars and automobiles. She was a native of France.
