

Mrs. Monlong Of Camarillo Dies

Mrs. Jean Monlong, pioneer resident of Camarillo, died yesterday morning after a seven-months illness. She was born in France on Jan. 7, 1860, and with her husband came to America and settled on the Adolfo Camarillo ranch in 1888, where they have lived ever since.

Mrs. Monlong had been in the service of the Camarillo family for the past 24 years, and her son, J. B. Monlong, is at present farming the Juan Camarillo property. She also is survived by her husband, a daughter living in Van Nuys, and seven grandchildren.

Requiem mass will be said at St. Clare's church, Oxnard, at 9 a. m. Friday, with rosary at Diefenderffer's undertaking parlors tonight at 8 o'clock.
