

Pioneer Rancher Called By Death

Jean Lacabanne, 70, retired pioneer rancher of Orange county, and a resident of Huntington Beach for the last 30 years, died at the French hospital in Los Angeles yesterday.

Mr. Lacabanne came to Orange county about 50 years ago from France. For several years he owned a sheep ranch near Katella and later lived in Anaheim.

The body has been taken to the Dixon Mortuary in Huntington Beach where the Rosary will be read tonight at 7:30 o'clock. Services will be held at the Dixon chapel tomorrow morning at 8:30 o'clock and requiem high mass will be said at St. Simon and Jude church at 9 o'clock. Burial will be in Holy Sepulchre cemetery.

Mr. Lacabanne, who was a bachelor, is survived by two brothers, Henry and Pierre of Huntington Beach.
