

## Funeral Tuesday For Peter Laxalt

Funeral services for Peter Laxalt, retired cattleman, who died in Reno Thursday, will be held Tuesday at 9:30 a.m. from the O'Brien-Rogers chapel, then to Our Lady of the Snows Catholic Church for a high requiem mass at 10 o'clock. Msgr. Patrick J. Connors, celebrant.

Interment will be in Mater Dolorosa cemetery. Recitation of the rosary is at the chapel, Monday at 8 p.m.

Mr. Laxalt was born in France in 1877 and first came to Reno and northern California in 1904. He served in the French army with the Zouaves.

For several years he made his home in Madeleine, Calif., where he was in the cattle business. In 1943, he sold his interests there and came to Reno to reside.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Mary Laxalt of Reno, two sons, Gabriel and Robert Laxalt of Susanville; two daughters, Adele Laxalt and Mrs. Lucille Etchberry of Reno and two brothers, J. P. Laxalt of Reno, Dominic Laxalt of Carson City and several nieces and nephews.
