

# Convicted Slayer Sentenced to Die; Life Term for Pal

CARRIZOZO, March 25 (AP)—A death sentence was given to one of the two men convicted last night of the murder of Pierre (Pete) Nalda, southeastern New Mexico ranchman shot to death Feb. 26.

Valeriano Alaniz, 44, was sentenced to die. Luis Campos, 30, was sentenced to life in prison. The jury made no recommendation for mercy.

Gracien Ernaut, 22-year-old nephew of Nalda, testified that Nalda was forced to write three checks by Alaniz and Campos. A short time later, outside the ranchhouse, Nalda and Ernaut made a run for it. He said that despite several shots he got away safely but his uncle later was found shot to death.
