

## Sisters, Natives Of Spain, Now U. S. Citizens

Two sisters, natives of Gara-  
oia, Spain, residents of Chino  
for many years, became full-  
fledged citizens of the United  
States, Wednesday of last week,  
when they successfully passed  
their citizenship examinations at  
San Bernardino, with a class of  
40, after taking work in the  
adult education classes at Chino  
high school.

The women are Mrs. Antonia  
Iriberry and Mrs. Manuela Eche-  
nique.

Mrs. Iriberry came to Los An-  
geles in 1904, and lived in sev-  
eral towns in the area until her  
marriage in 1912 in Anaheim to  
Mike Iriberry, who came from  
Spain in 1906.

The couple established their  
home at Brea, and moved to Chi-  
no in 1918 with their three chil-  
dren, Catherine (Mrs. Joe Guisa-  
sola), Marie and Joe. A fourth  
child, Marian was born here. All  
are graduates of Chino high  
school and Catherine attended  
Pomona Junior college. She now  
heads the local American Legion  
auxiliary, and has been stress-  
ing its citizenship program.

Mrs. Echenique came direct to  
Chino in January, 1921, to the  
home of another sister, Mrs.  
Frank Chilbolost, and the fol-  
lowing May married Esteban  
Echenique, who passed away  
several years ago. They also had  
four children, two daughters,  
Juana and Marie, both of whom  
are graduates of Chino high  
school, and two sons, Philip and  
Fruencio. Military service in-  
terrupted Philip's high school  
years. Both boys now live in  
Lancaster. Juana lives here with  
her mother, and Marie is in Ger-  
many with her husband, Captain  
Francis Webre, and three chil-  
dren. Captain Webre is in the  
radar division of the air corps  
at Brechensfeld.

Both Mrs. Iriberry and Mrs.  
Echenique studied in Miss Imal-  
do Nieto's citizenship classes,  
Mrs. Iriberry attending since last  
September, and Mrs. Echenique  
taking a brief course in U. S.  
government after her daughter,  
Juana, had helped her with  
much of her citizenship prepara-  
tion.
