Michel Ohaco of Wickenburg, pioneer Arizona sheep rancher, died Friday in a Wickenburg hospital. He was 71. Services and burial will be in Phoenix.

Mr. Ohaco came to Arizona from the Basque country of France in 1899. He had extensive ranching interests in Winslow and Central Arizona.
