

Mission Rites Unite Scions of Pioneers

SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO. The marriage of Miss Carmel Avila and Ambrosio Marcel Ebargaray unites two of the oldest families in Orange County history. The Rev. Vincent Lloyd Russell conducted the ceremonies at the Father Serra Chapel in the Old Mission, preceded by a nuptial mass read by the Rev. Philip Mellady.

Mrs. Ebargaray is the daughter of the Joseph Avilas and Ebargaray the son of the John Ebargarays. All are lifetime residents of San Juan Capistrano. Both families

figured prominently in the history of the Mission Village and at one time owned large Spanish grants, parts of which were consolidated into the famed Santa Margarita Ranch, now Camp Pendleton.

Following the ceremonies breakfast was served for the wedding party in Old Mission Hall which was also the scene of an afternoon reception for family members and guests. Both Ebargaray and his bride were graduated from San Juan Capistrano schools. They plan to make their home here.
