PETER ETCHEBERRY

Peter Etcheberry, a dairy rancher in the Chino valley for 15 years, passed away at his home in Riverside Jan. 11, after a long period of illness. Services were held in Riverside Saturday morning with interment in a Riverside cemetery.

Mrs. Etcheberry, 80 at the time of his death, was born May 26, 1875, in Banca, France, in the French Basque Pyrenees. When he was 18 he came to this country, settling in the San Jacinto valley. He ran a dairy there until coming to the Chino area in 1935. He retired in 1950 and moved to Riverside, his home until his death.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Marie Etcheberry, and seven children, all of whom were at his bedside during his last illness. They are Mrs. Leona Benton, Ontario; Mrs. Juanita Garat and Mrs. Bernice Brown, Riverside; Mrs. Marie Dominagonio, Winchester; Mrs. Julia Snider, Wilmington, Mrs. Antoinette Barcelona, Chino, and Joe Etcheberry, Azusa.
