

Eureka Man Dies in Elko

Joe Sorholus 70, of Eureka, died Tuesday at Elko General Hospital after having been confined to the hospital since last Thursday.

Mr. Sorholus, who was born Oct. 27, 1885, in France, had lived in this country for 53 years and was a naturalized citizen. He operated the Gold Bar in Eureka.

He moved to the western part of the United States in 1914, and shortly after coming to this area he enlisted in the French army, serving from 1914 to 1917.

He was a charter member and past president of Eureka Lions club and a member of St. Brendan's Catholic church.

Mr. Sorholus is survived by his widow, Jeanne; a son, Albert; a brother, John, and a nephew, Pete, all of Eureka.
