# Driver Killed When SP Train Strikes Car

Traffic accidents claimed three more lives in Los Angeles County yesterday, including a member of a pioneer Pomona Valley family who drove his sedan into the path of an on-rushing Southern Pacific streamliner.

The victim was Justin Carrey, 76, of 20330 Carrey Road,

Walnut, where his family has had large farm holdings since 1895.

Highway Patrolman Tom Elliott said the Golden State Limited from New Orleans was highballing at 70 m.p.h. when it struck Carrey's car at the Valley Blvd. crossing in Spadra.

The motor, transmission, seats and other pieces of the car were strewn along the track for 300 yards.

Robert Foster, 45, of 6218 N Sultana Ave., Temple City, told Elliott he was waiting in the morning fog at the crossing when Carrey's car drove past him onto the tracks.

Because of the crash, Engineer Earl Lay was an hour and a half late bringing the streamliner into Los Angeles.
