## Pierre Ardans

Pierre Ardans, 61, died at the Nudene Hotel Wednesday.

Born Sept. 19, 1898, in France, he spent his early years there. He came to the United States as a young man. He first lived in Montana and in 1929 moved to Idaho where he worked in the sheep business in the Pocatello and Blackfoot area. At the time of his death he was employed by Leonard Cousin of Shelley. When in Pocatello, he made his home at 345 North Hayes.

Mr. Ardans had served in the French Army. He was a member of St. Joseph's Church.
