

## Mrs. Coscarart Taken By Death At 71 In San Diego

Victoria Ann Coscarart, 71, of 602 South Orange Street, resident of the county all her life and resident of Escondido for about 55 years, died Thursday in San Diego.

She passed away at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Helen Files while on a visit. Mrs. Coscarart was the widow of Pedro Coscarart, at one time foreman for the Daley Ranch, and was the mother of major league baseball player Pete Coscarart, once with the Dodgers when the team was in Brooklyn.
