ELKO—Jose M. Alberro, 81, a resident of Elko for nearly 60 years, died early Wednesday morning at his home here.

He was born Feb. 19, 1889 in Arnoz, Navarra, Spain and came to Elko County in 1911. He worked as a shepherd for about 10 years and was also employed by Western Pacific Railroad. In 1924, Alberro went to work for French Bakery (now Home Bakery) and stayed there until retiring last year.
