

## Irigaray mass scheduled

**BUFFALO** — The funeral mass for Joseph Irigaray, 84, will be celebrated at 2:30 p.m. Friday at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church.

The rosary will be recited at 7:30 p.m. Thursday at the Adams Funeral Home Chapel with burial in Willow Grove Cemetery.

Irigaray died Tuesday evening at Johnson County Memorial Hospital.

He was born Feb. 22, 1895, at Esterencuby, France, where he was reared and educated. Irigaray came to the United States in 1914, and lived Ely, Nev., where he was a shepherd. He later moved to California where he worked as a lumberjack. He moved to Buffalo in 1930, where he herded sheep for his brother,

Gaston Irigaray. Irigaray later went into the sheep business for himself, south of Buffalo, in the Four Mile area. He retired in the late 1960's and moved into Buffalo where he lived at the Idlewild Hotel until June, 1978, when he moved to the Amie Hole Nursing Home.

Survivors are four sisters, Anna Uhart of Ventura, Calif., Elizabeth Lerossa, Marie Hegoburu, and Marie Maitia, all of France; and one niece, Mary Lawrence and one nephew, Joseph Irigaray, both of Buffalo.
