

Alice M. Indiano Dangberg

GARDNERVILLE — Alice M. Indiano Dangberg, 74, died Oct. 17, 1996, in Carmichael, Calif.

A native of Reno, she was born April 30, 1922, to Michael and Jeanne Marie Etchebarren Indiano, and had lived in Carson Valley most of her life.

Mrs. Dangberg worked as a secretary for the Selective Service System for 20 years and Emery Graunke Accounting Firm in the 1950s and 1960s.

She was a long time member of the Carson Valley Historical Society, St. Gall Catholic Church, Gardnerville, attended elementary school in Fredericksberg, Calif., and graduated from Douglas County High School in 1939.
