

Death of Romain Grand.

Romain Grand, one of the oldest and best known of the French residents of this city, died yesterday at his home on Macy street on Boyle Heights. He was born at the village of Mirpoux, Conton de Nay, Basses Pyrenees, France, January 26, 1846. He came to Los Angeles in 1866, and had resided here ever since. In 1869 he founded the Grand Carriage factory on Aliso street, and for more than thirty years he did business at that place. Mr. Grand's aged mother still lives in France. He leaves a wife, four daughters and two sons, who reside in this city. The funeral will be held on Sunday afternoon from the old Plaza Church.
