PIONEER TAKEN.

**Frenchman who had Lived here
Forty-five years Passes After
a Long Sickness.**

Peter Darancette, a Frenchman who had resided in Los Angeles and vicinity for forty-five years, died yesterday at his home No. 352 North Indiana street, after a long sickness. He leaves a widow, a daughter, Mrs. Amelia Young of Bakersfield, and two young sons, who live with their mother here. Funeral services will be conducted tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock from the chapel of Cunningham & O'Connor. Interment will be at Calvary. Father Ardans of the Church of Our Lady of Lourdes officiating.

Mr. Darancette was a native of Southern France, coming to this country when 19 years old. He was 64 at the time of his death. Up to ten years ago he raised sheep and grapes in the vicinity of La Crescenta.
